INFOSPHERIX TO OPEN INDIANA CONTACT CENTER New Facility Near Indianapolis Could Employ 200 Residents

BELTSVILLE, MD (NASDAQ/SPEX). InfoSpherix Incorporated will open a new contact center facility in Carmel, Indiana, a suburb of Indianapolis. The Company has signed a building lease and begun hiring management personnel. The center will house up to 110 call center seats for agents who will process reservations for camping in Indiana State Parks, as well as handle calls for other projects. Considering multiple work shifts, this center could employ more than 200 local area residents. InfoSpherix currently operates its call center projects in Maryland and South Dakota. The consolidation will establish Carmel as the Company's Midwestern hub of operations.

Slated to open in spring 2006, the site will also serve as a parallel call center with InfoSpherix's Cumberland, Maryland facility to share resources and provide disaster recovery capability. The site will house a full complement of support personnel, including reservation and customer service specialists, supervisors, project managers, and technical and administrative staff. InfoSpherix also plans to operate other call center contracts from the Carmel site, adding even more jobs to the region.

InfoSpherix President and CEO Richard Levin said, "We've had an excellent working relationship with the government and people of Indiana, so it was natural for us to look at the state when we decided we needed a new facility. What we found was excellent infrastructure, a friendly business climate, and a lot of talented people with a great work ethic, so in the end, moving to Carmel was an opportunity we simply couldn't pass up.

InfoSpherix is a government contractor that specializes in designing and operating a broad range of contact centers and park reservation programs. Its ReserveWorld business line includes the National Park Service, 12 states, and three counties. The company also operates other types of contact center programs for four federal agencies and is the preferred call center provider for Maryland state government. InfoSpherix is a wholly owned subsidiary of Beltsville, Maryland-based Spherix Incorporated.
